GUIDELINES

- To be eligible for the 2021 Knights of Columbus Council #3205 Scholarship(s) the applicant must meet one of the following criteria:
 - A 2021 high school senior **actively involved** in STAY (St. Thomas Aquinas Youth), who has been accepted to a 2 or 4 -year college or trade school
 - A member of Knights of Columbus council #3205 or child, grandchild or great grandchild of a council #3205 member. The applicant must be a high school senior who has been accepted to a 2 or 4-year college/university or trade school or currently enrolled in a 2 or 4 year college/university or trade school or enrolled in an undergraduate program at a 4-year university.
- Previous scholarship winners are **not** eligible
- The applicant must submit the application package by **April 30, 2021**. The package will include:
 - Completed Informational sheet
 - Photocopy of current year Knights of Columbus membership card or signed recommendation of STA youth director
 - Summary of activities (include number of years or hours you were involved, any volunteer work you may have done, and any offices held).
 - School
 - Church
 - Community
 - Essay (@700 words) "In light of the world and national events in 2020, what role did your Catholic faith play in helping you through a challenging event or events?" You may exceed 700 words to complete your story or statement. Do not exceed 800 words.
 - Use Arial 12 font for the essay
 - 2 short answer scenarios @ 100 words each
 - Short answers scenarios should be in a conversational style
 - You may exceed 100 words to complete a story or statement. Do not exceed 150 words on each scenario
 - Use Arial 12 font for the two scenarios

Do NOT include your name or family member names in the context of your summary of activities or your essay or short answer scenarios.

All applications become the property of the Knights of Columbus Council #3205. The summaries, short-answer scenarios and essays will be judged by a committee of outside personnel to avoid any conflict of interest. In case of a tie, the scholarship selection committee (judges) will break the tie. All decisions made by the council scholarship committee are final.
