#### **GUIDELINES**

- To be eligible for the 2023 Knights of Columbus Council #3205 Scholarship the applicant must meet one of the following criteria:
  - o A 2023 High School Senior **actively involved** in STAY (St. Thomas Aguinas Youth)
  - o A member of Knights of Columbus Council #3205
  - A child, grandchild or great grandchild of a Council #3205 member (living or deceased)
  - The applicant must be a graduating senior in high school who has been accepted to a two or 4-year college or trade school OR a member of Knights of Columbus Council #3205, OR a child, grandchild or great grandchild of a Council #3205 member currently enrolled in a two-year college or trade school or enrolled in an undergrad program at a 4-year college
- Previous scholarship winners are **not** eligible
- The applicant must complete the application package by March 18, 2023. The package will include:
  - o Completed Informational sheet
  - Photocopy of current year Knights of Columbus membership card or signed recommendation of STA youth director
  - Essay (700-800 words) How has your Catholic faith helped you overcome a challenge in your life?
    - Use Arial 12 font, double-spaced for your essay.
  - Summary of Activities
    - Summary of activities (include number of years or hours you were involved, any volunteer work you may have done, and any offices held). Part time jobs can be listed in this section).
      - Church + volunteer work
      - School + volunteer work
      - Community + volunteer work
      - Paid P/T employment
  - o 2 short answer scenarios
    - Short answer scenarios must be in a conversational style
    - If words of another persons work are used, please reference the work
    - Use Arial 12 font, double spaced for the two scenarios



Do NOT include your name or family member names in the context of your summary of activities, essay or short answer scenarios.

When using acronyms, make sure the acronym is spelled out the first time it is used in your application. i.e., STAY (St. Thomas Aquinas Youth), NHS (National Honor Society), Consol (A&M Consolidated High School). All members of the selection committee are from out of town and may not be familiar with some of these organizations.
